

Important Steps to Follow When Transferring a Vehicle

- Transfer/tax form APV9T must be completely filled out and **signed by both the purchaser and seller** (if the seller is a company, someone with signing authority must sign, along with their first & last name and title)
- ICBC will not accept forms that have errors, cross-offs, or alterations of any kind
- The purchaser must have the seller's most recent **original computer printed signed registration form** (if the seller is a company, someone with signing authority must sign, along with their first & last name and title)
- Seller must complete selling price
- Tax (pst of 12%) is payable by purchaser at the time of transfer on the purchase price, certain vehicles will pay a luxury tax
- Gift transactions (for approved "related individuals") require a consumer taxation branch "gift of a vehicle" form to be fully completed in order to qualify for gift exemption.
- The presentation of accepted identification is required at the time of transfer (ex. Valid bc driver's license with photo, passport, bcid, permanent resident card etc)
